
Operating Style Performance

When choosing windows, consider the performance of each window style as well as the weather conditions in your area. The more adverse the weather conditions, the better performance you need.




Single Glider
The sash slides from side-to-side.



Double Hung
Both the top and bottom
sashes slide for total air
movement control.



Single HungThe bottom sash slides up for controlled air movement.



Bay & Bow
Using combinations of fixed,
single hung and casement
units, you can make a room
larger; ideal for extra seating,
or to open up a small kitchen.



Awning

Opens from the bottom using a top hinge; ensures constant air movement.



Casement

Opens outward like a door and is hinged on the side; provides good air circulation.



Fixed

Looks like a casement or awning but cannot open.

More glass surface allows a clear, unobstructed view through the glass.
